

What is FACT?

Client Assessment

All participants in FACT are required to go through several assessments to determine their individual needs. These include:

- Diagnostic ~ Evaluate client's mental health, developmental disability, or substance abuse condition
- Alcohol and Drug ~ Evaluate any issues with alcohol or other drugs
- Job and Family Services ~ Determine eligibility for assistance through the Allen County Department of Job and Family Services

Programs

In addition to the client assessments, clients are expected to take part in a number of programs dedicated to personal growth. The classes required for all clients are:

- Nurturing Fathers for Life (NFL)~
The NFL class is a parenting program designed to help fathers achieve economic stability, establish healthy relationships and make a positive impact on the lives of their children.
- Moral Reconciliation Therapy ~
Facilitated by Coleman Behavioral Health ~ Teaches clients to think about the impact and consequences of life experiences and choices
- Pre-Employment Training (PET)~
Educational classes aimed at delivering client's employment related topics for them to be better prepared for the workplace
- GED/ABLE Classes

Other classes are required, depending on the results of each client's individual assessment.

Examples include:

- Anger Management
- Batterer's Intervention
- Twelve-Step Support Groups
- Individual/Group Counseling
- MRT Trauma-Substance Use Disorders
- AOD Awareness

Potential clients are invited to attend an orientation to explain the program's purpose, and the classes and services that are offered.


