



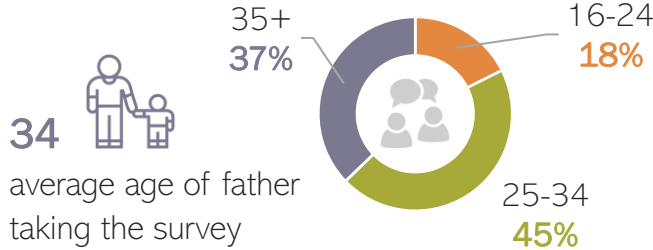

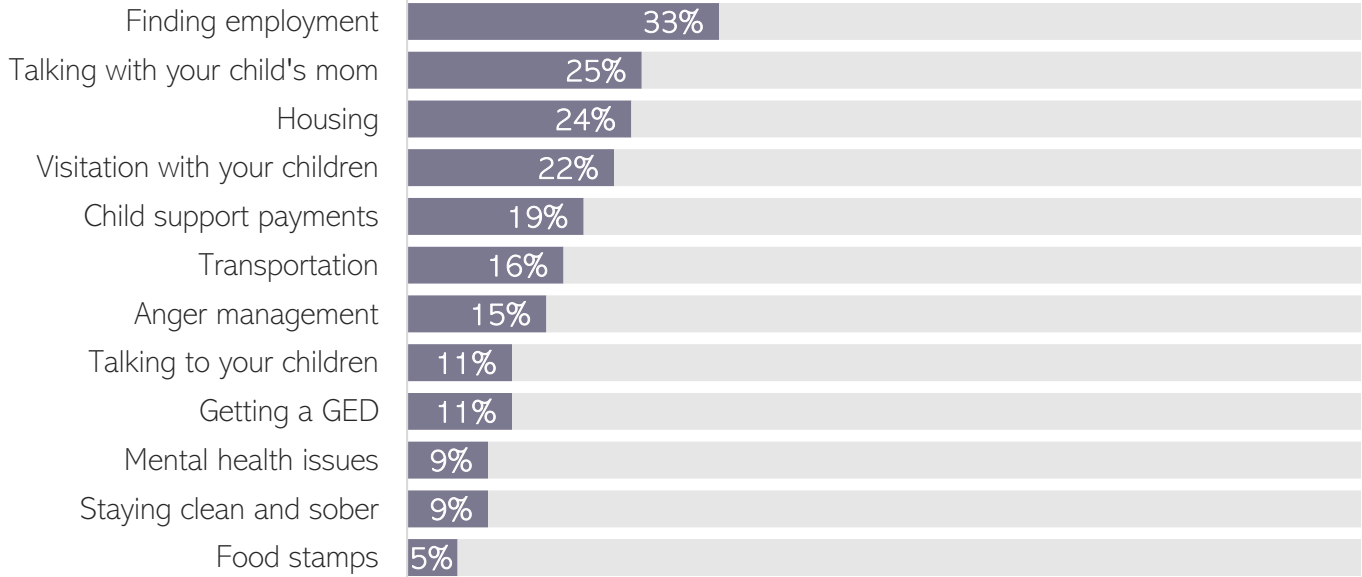
Age of fathers completing the survey:



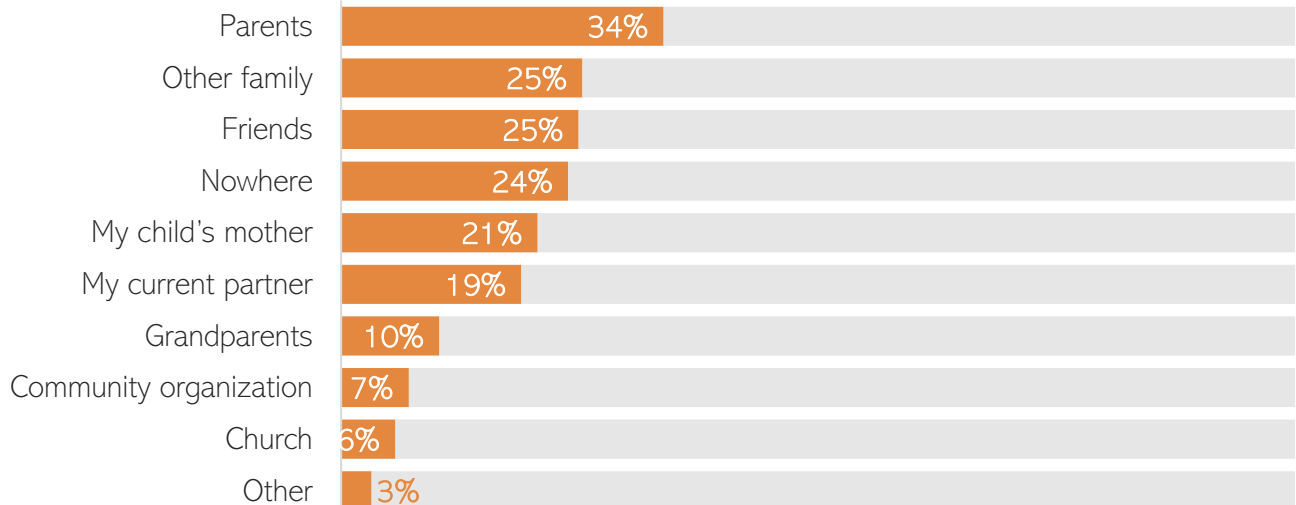

Did you sign the birth certificate of your child?

80% yes
20% no



Do you have child support arrears?

30% yes
70% no



Of those with arrears, 12% owe less than \$1,000, 34% owe between \$1k-\$5k, 14% owe between \$5k-\$10k, and 41% owe more than \$10k.

How often do you spend time with your children?

33% daily
33% weekly

8% weekends only
11% monthly
15% not at all



How is communication with your child's mother?



16% we don't communicate
35% difficult
50% easy

What is your current living situation?

71% I have housing and I do not plan to move within the next 6 months

18% I have housing, but I have to move within the next 3 months

10% My housing is unstable

1% I have been homeless within the past 6 months

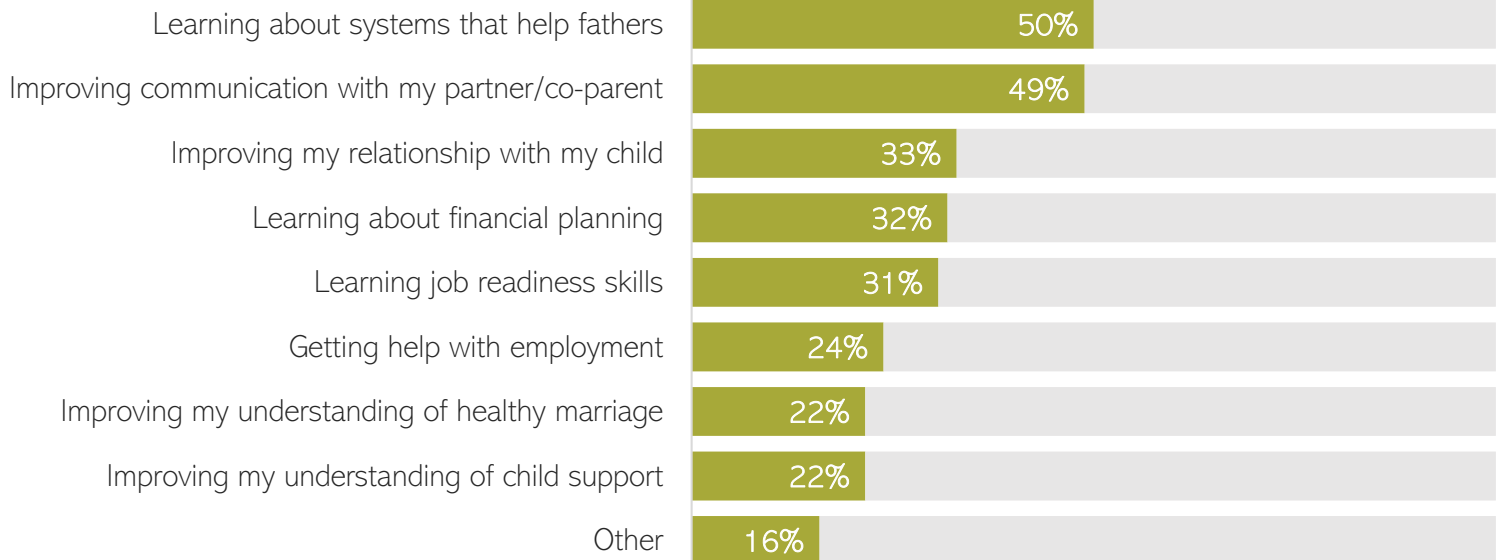
Do you currently have a job?

54% yes
46% no

Of those without a job, 21% said transportation was affecting their employment status.
