## OCF Offering Free InsideOut Dad Curriculum Training

The Ohio Commission on Fatherhood (OCF) is sponsoring a free, virtual two-day training on the evidence-based fatherhood curriculum InsideOut Dad. The training will be held virtually from October 14-15. **Participants must attend both days to receive a certificate. Participants will be required to return the curriculum to OCF if both sessions are not fully attended.** If you are not available on both days or if you have previously been trained in this curriculum, please do NOT register, as seating is limited. See the frequently asked questions below for more details.

### Who should attend this training?

If you work with fathers and want to use an evidence-based fatherhood curriculum, this training is for you. This training is intended for new fatherhood practitioners who have not previously been trained on how to teach and facilitate classes using InsideOut Dad. During the training, participants will experience some of the exercises and activities in InsideOut Dad that generate introspection and awareness-building.

### How many from my organization may register?

No more than two from your organization may register. Multiple individuals may view the training from one registration link (as long as all health and safety guidelines are maintained), but only the two registrants may participate in the training activities and receive the certification.

### How many tickets will I need to register for?

Just one for both days. Be prepared to provide your name, organization name, email address, and the mailing address for the curriculum training packet.

### Will there be a wait list?

There may be. Registration is limited to the first 40 who sign up, but the Commission on Fatherhood will maintain a wait list in the event of cancellations.

### Do I need to purchase the curriculum?

No. The Ohio Commission on Fatherhood is purchasing the curriculum for up to 25 participants. Only one curriculum is provided to each organization represented.
